The Tomorrow Fund is the only local non-profit organization that provides daily financial and emotional support to children with cancer and their families, from the time of diagnosis throughout the entire course of treatment—and beyond.

In 1985 The Tomorrow Fund was created by a group of local citizens to help children with cancer and their families in Rhode Island. The founders included physicians, teachers, child development experts and parents of children with cancer.

At this time more than 90% of children diagnosed with cancer in Rhode Island and southeastern Massachusetts are treated in The Tomorrow Fund Clinic at Hasbro Children's Hospital. Widely recognized for the high quality of its oncology treatments and medical services, The clinic is also noted for its compassionate approach to children and their families.

Services provided by The Tomorrow Fund to include direct financial assistance for both the big and small costs associated with the diagnosis. Psycho-social support is also provided by experienced professionals who work through The Tomorrow Fund Clinic and with patients at bedside.

I have yet to work with an organization with a bigger heart or stronger integrity. I get to see, on a weekly basis through my work as resident cartoonist at Hasbro Children's Hospital, how The Tomorrow Fund continues to remove emotional and financial stress from families going through the most challenging experience most can imagine.
